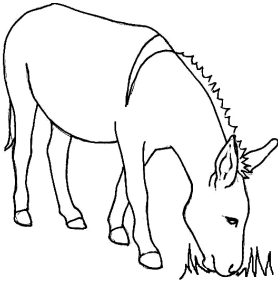

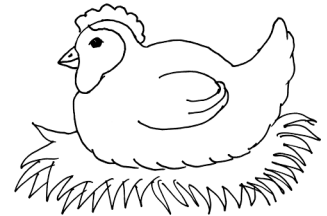
# Children and Animals are protected by the law and may not be harmed

## How can YOU help animals?



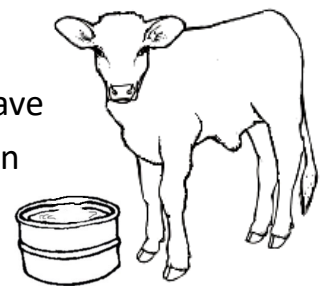
If it is your responsibility to let the animals out of the kraal so they can go and graze, make sure you do this before you play. They will be hungry and it is not kind to keep them waiting.

Can you cut some nice fresh grass to put into the laying box inside your chicken pen? The hen can lay her eggs in a clean place and the eggs will not be dirty. Check she has water.



Litter is not good for the environment and if animals eat litter they can get sick and die. You can help by throwing your litter in the dustbin, encouraging your friends to do the same. You can also pick up litter in the veld, street or yard and throw it in the dustbin.

Any animal that is kept inside the yard or kraal must have some shelter from the hot sun or the rain. And of course they must have water or they can become dehydrated, sick and irritable. You can be a good helper by filling up the water bowls or troughs.

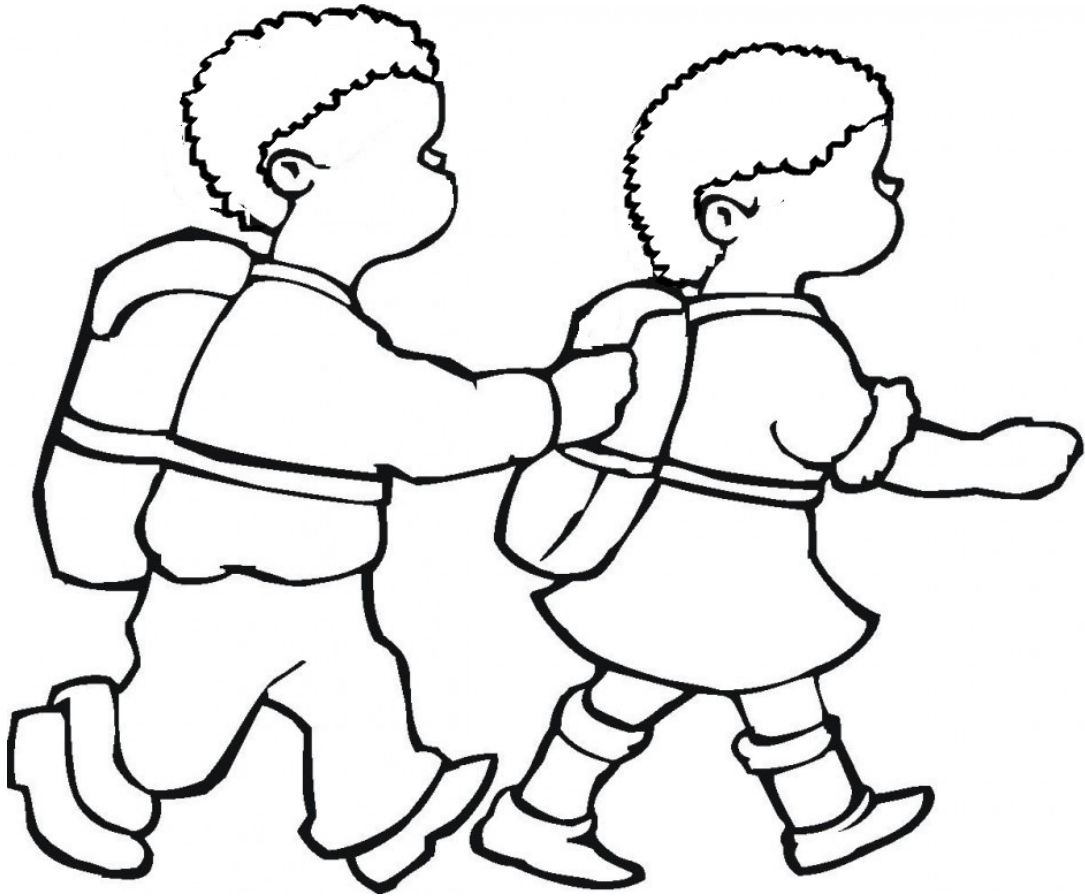


If you have a dog make sure you spend time every day talking to them and playing with them. They can get lonely and sad if they are ignored. You can be a good friend.

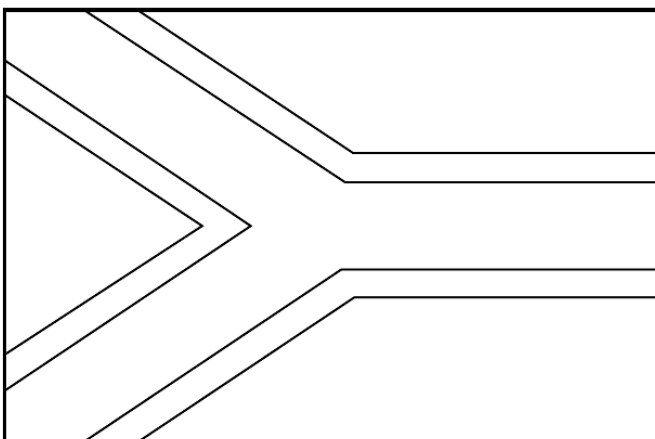

Fire can destroy homes, crops, grazing and equipment

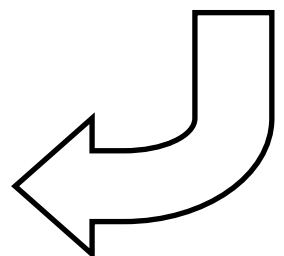
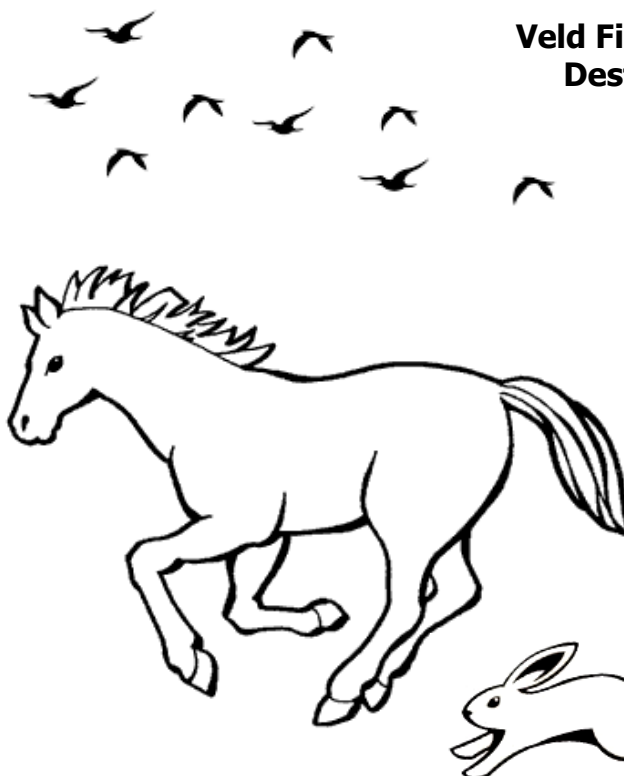

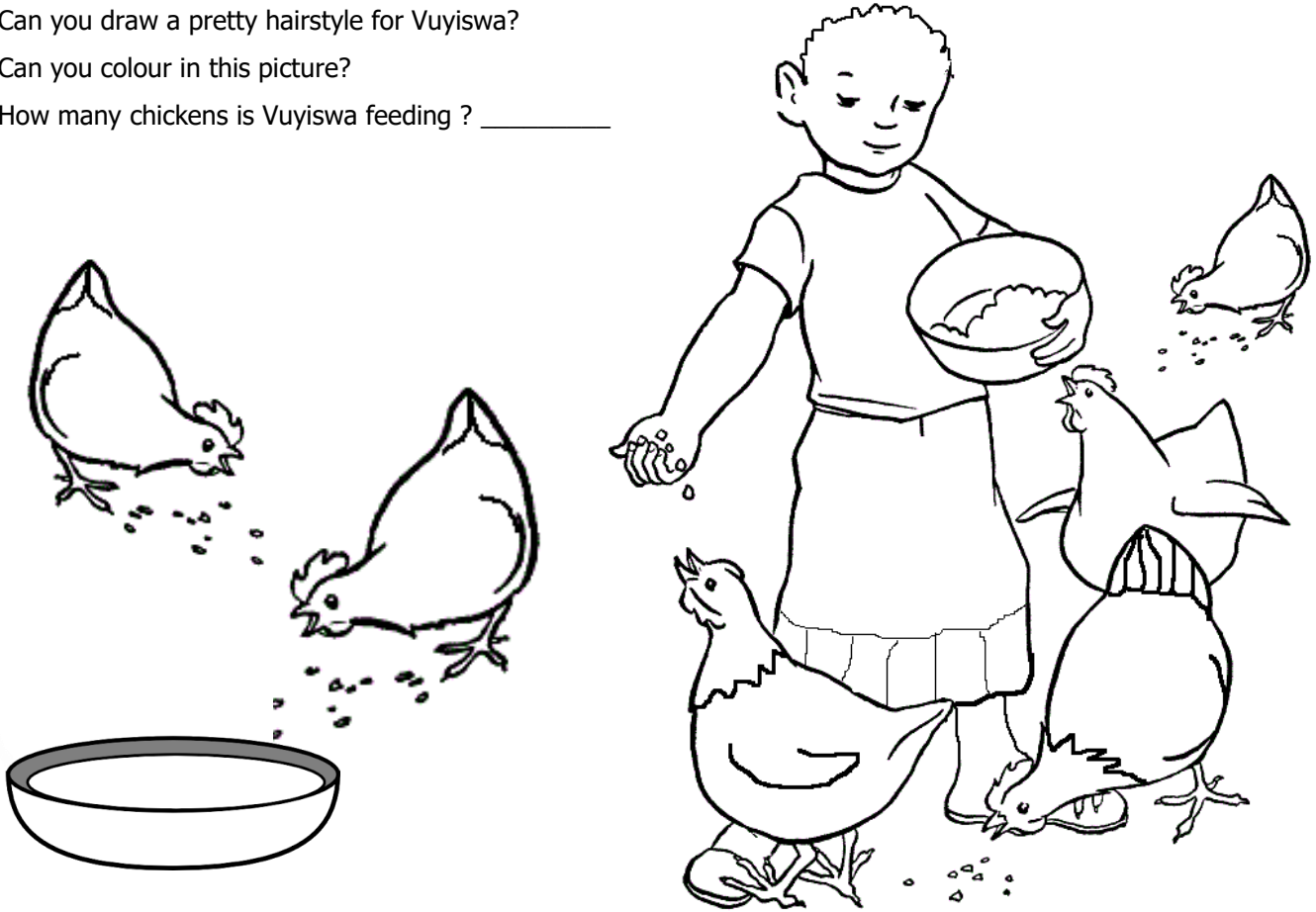
# HELPING EACH OTHER

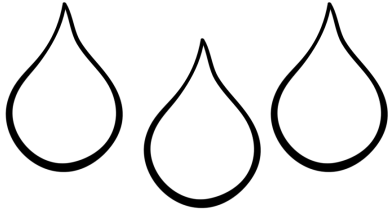

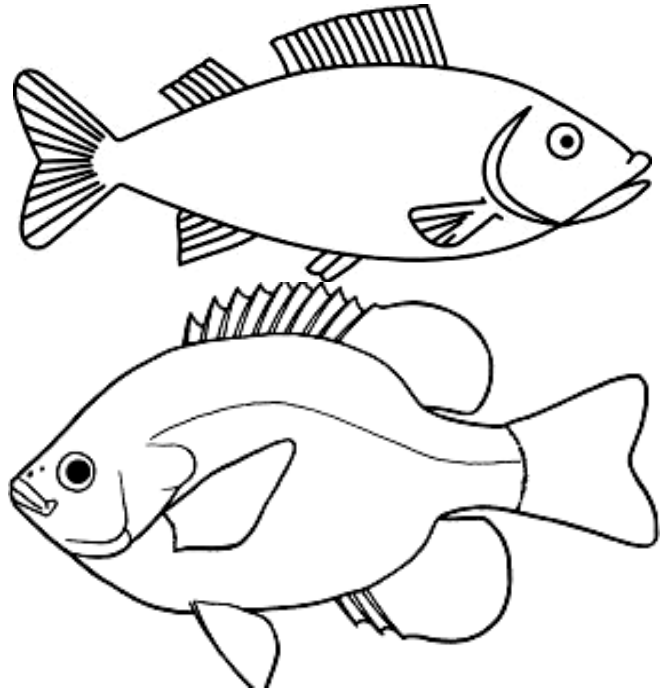


## WATER IS PRECIOUS

not waste water or pollute rivers.

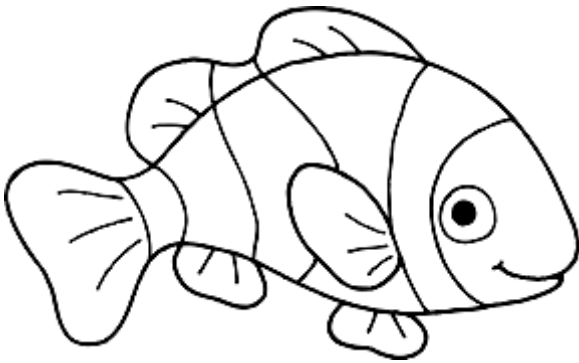

We need to make sure that we look after them well so that they stay fit and healthy.

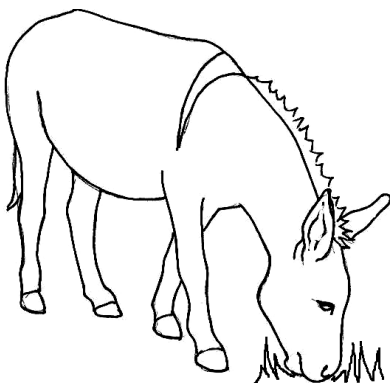
Don't whip them. A smart driver can use his voice and whistles

# SPCA

**What does SPCA stand for?** Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals

**What does the SPCA do?** Protects all animals and provides education to owners

**What animals do the SPCA care for?** All animals—big and small

**What is an SPCA Inspector?**

A law enforcement officer who enforces the national law that protects animals

**Is the SPCA a government department?** No.

The SPCA is a non-governmental organisation (NGO) and does not get any government funding but relies on public donation

**What is the law that protects animals?** The Animals Protection Act No 71 of 1962.

**Is it against the law to harm animals?** Yes.

Animals must be properly cared for and treated well.

**What happens if someone is cruel to an animal?**

They can be prosecuted and if found guilty they can be sentenced to jail and or they can get a fine and will get a criminal record.
